

Information Services – Sue Hastings, DSO-IS

The Flotilla Staff Officer for Information Services (FSO-IS) in your Flotilla should be the first person to contact if you have a problem or question related to what forms to use, AUXDATA database and Auxinfo reports. If he/she cannot answer the question, the FSO-IS will send it up the IS chain of command as listed below:

Member >FSO-IS >SO-IS >ADSO-IS Sector/DSO-IS >National Department Staff

Sue Hastings, DSO-IS – District liaison with National and District Staff and Leaders on IS issues. Troubleshooting problems in District, maintain D7 AuxInfo Reports on website, District 7 Awards (AUXDATA/AuxInfo Reports), District/Division/Flotilla AUXDATA Password Coordinator, IS training programs, enter 4 Hr. TCT Workshops into AUXDATA via D7 Help Tickets, Sector Charleston (Div. 2/10/12) point of contact.

Ed Duda, ADSO-IS Special Projects/Sector Jacksonville – backup for DSO-IS when not available (Passwords, troubleshooting, etc.), any special projects as requested, Sector Jacksonville (Div. 4/14/17) point of contact.

Ben Ostrovsky, ADSO-IS Awards/Sector Miami – enters/troubleshoots Awards as requested by DIRAUX (D7 Help Tickets), Sector Miami (Div. 3/5/6) point of contact.

Peter Godoy, ADSO-IS Air – responsible for doing Approvals of all Air missions (from AOM) and making corrections for Air missions in AUXDATA.

Bob Cook, ADSO-IS ICS – responsible for entering ICS courses in AUXDATA and troubleshooting problems or making corrections in AUXDATA.

Betty Bullock, ADSO-IS Sector Key West/San Juan – Sector Key West (Div. 13) and Sector San Juan (Div. 1/16) point of contact.

Ruth Bruno, ADSO-IS Sector St. Petersburg – Sector St. Petersburg (Div. 7/8/9/11/15) point of contact.

The contact person for SOs-IS will be your Sector POC (point of contact). Relay any questions/problems to them and they will work with you to fix and if still a problem, it will be relayed to me (or Ed). This will spread the workload out for the IS Team.
